
CAMPUS CODE OF CONDUCT FOR STUDENTS

- Students are expected to maintain the highest standards of discipline and behave in a dignified manner both inside as well as outside the College campus. They shall abide by the rules and regulations of the College and should act in a way that highlights the strict discipline and the excellent reputation of the College.
- 2. All the students are expected to be present in the class well within time. Students shall rise from their seats when the teacher enters the class room and remain standing till the teacher takes her / his seat or they are allowed by the teacher to sit. Silence shall be observed during class hours. No student shall enter or leave the class room while a class is in progress without the permission of the teacher concerned.
- 3. Teachers shall be greeted appropriately with "Good Morning Sir/Madam" or "Good Afternoon Sir/Madam" when they enter the class room and a "Thank you Sir/Madam" when the teacher leaves the class room.
- 4. All students shall leave the classrooms immediately after the classes are over. No students shall wander or gather in the verandah, corridors, staircases, etc. They should not spend much time in canteens, coffee shops, etc.
- 5. All the students are expected to attend college functions, seminars, and conferences and be present for the entirety of all such events.
- 6. All the students must wear their identity cards, which should be properly displayed. The identity card is a public documentand all teaching staff and non-teaching staff have the right to examine it. Denial of that alone willinvite disciplinary action.
- All kinds of tattooing, body piercing, hair styling, etc. that go against existing social norms will be referred to the Disciplinary Committee. Any dresscode violations noticed within the campus will initiate further disciplinary action.
- 8. Students are expected to maintain silence in the academic buildings to maintain decorum. Any deviant behaviour such as hooting, whistling, loitering, etc. will be treated as instances of indiscipline.
- 9. For independent study, students are expected to use the class rooms, the library or the demarcated areas of the academic building. They shall not resort to sitting on staircases or other areas where they could interfere with the free movement of others.
- 10. Students are encouraged to make use of the library andthe common computing facilities, and also to involve themselves inprofessional body activities and programmes authorized by the college beyond class hours. However, under normal circumstances, students shall return to their hostels or residences by 6p.m.
- Students are expected to keep the campus neat and clean. They should not put any waste anywhere in the campus except in the waste baskets/bins.
- 12. Consumption of intoxicants or psychotropic substances in any form, smoking, or using chewinggum, panmasala, etc. are strictly prohibited inside the campus.


- 13. It is strongly advised to refrain from activities such as scribbling or noting on walls, doors or furniture, which could damage the college and destroy the academic ambience.
- 14. Students are advised to be very careful while handling the furniture, equipment, fixtures and appliances of the college and laboratories. Careless handling or misuse of these objects could result inphysical injuries or damage to property. Follow safety precautions near moving machines and electrical installations. In the event ofdamage of property, the responsible students will have to bear the cost of replacement/repairalong with a fine.
- 15. Students are not permitted to arrange any unauthorized celebrations and decorations of any kind in the campus.
- 16. Students are not permitted to distribute or display (both physically and electronically) material such as notices, banners etc. in the campus without the permission of the competent authority.
- 17. Students are expected to make use of academic, co-curricular and extracurricular facilities available as much as possible. This will make them physically fit, academically competent, mentally alert and socially sensitive.
- 18. Students who intend to represent the college in intercollegiate events shall take prior permission from the concerned head of the department and the selection will be based on parameters such as academic performance, attendance, character and competence of the student in the proposed event for participation.
- 19. Unauthorized meetings, propaganda work, processions, or fund collections are forbidden within the college, the hostels, and the college grounds and approach roads.
- 20. Harassing juniors, ill-treatment of fellow students or any form of ragging is objectionable and liable to be treated as a criminal offence by law enforcment agencies as per the directives of the Supreme Court of India.
- 21. Misbehaviour towards women students or, use of threats or violence against members of the staff or fellow students will be considered to be very serious cases of misconduct.
- 22. Any violation of the rules stated here will invite penalties in the form of warnings, fines, summoning of parents, or any course of corrective measure found suitable by any staff member or the higher authority of the college.
- 23. **Mobile Phone Policy:** The purpose of this policy is to establish clear cut guidelines regarding the usage of mobile phones insidethe campus. This policy is applicable to students who enter the college campus. Realizing the importance of communication and the possible impact of mobile phone usage inside the campus, the following guidelines have been prescribed:
 - (i) Students are not permitted to use mobile phones without enough cause within the campus. However, the use of phones for academic purposes is allowed if prior permission from a teacher has been taken. Mobile phones must be kept in silent mode during class hours.
 - (ii) Accessing social networking sites such as Facebook, Whatsapp, Twitter, etc. is prohibited within the college campus. However, access to these sites is permitted in the hostel buildings during time slots specified by the hostel wardens.

Important Informations

- 1. Geography at the H.S. level is mandatory in order to opt for geography in B.Sc. / B.A. General Degree course.
- 2. Students who have studied vocational courses at the Plus 2 level are eligible for subject specific General Degree courses. Students who have qualified from Rabindra Mukta Vidyalaya (technical courses) are eligible for candidature in different subjects as per the University guidelines.
- 3. The eligibility of students belonging to the SC / ST / OBC / PH / VH will be considered as per the Govt. guidelines.
- 4. The Principal's decision regarding matters of admission is final. In all matters related to the admission procedure, the latest notice issued by the University will be considered final.
- 5. Students who have qualified in the H.S. this year, along with H.S-qualified students from the last two years, are eligible for admission in the first semester. All students except for those who have qualified this year will have to mention their previous institution and provide valid transfer and registration certificates before admission. Those who have never been admitted to any college previously will have to provide satisfactory proof. Guardians are required to sign an undertaking.
- 6. All other important notifications will be available on the college notice board.
- 7. Eligible students are required to contact the concerned authorities with a proper income certificate to apply for concessions.
- 8. No application for change of subject(s) will be entertained after registration / enrollment at the university.
- 9. Admission to M.Sc. / M.A. Courses is under the control of the university.
- 10. Attested photocopies of these documents should be attached with the application form Marksheets of the last passed examination and Marksheets of the M.P. Examination, the Admit Card of the Madhyamik(Class 10) Examination, the School Leaving Certificate, the Caste Certificate (if applicable), PH/VH Certificate (if applicable), and an original copy of the Declaration on Stamp Paper duly signed by Student and Guardian, where applicable. All original documents should be produced during verification.
- 11. All students should collect a photo identity card from the college after admission.
- 12. There will be Internal Assessments in every semester and the marks of it will be added with marks of each End semester Examination.
- 13. According to University Guidelines, students should have 75% attendance and should appear in all the Internal Examinations conducted by the college to be eligible to appear for the University examinations or apply for student concessions or scholarships.
- 14. Students should regularly follow the college notice board for information and fill up forms for registration and enrolment within the due date to be eligible to appear for the university examinations.
- 15. The college has NCC and NSS units. Students should register their name in them through applications to the respective office.
- 16. In case of irregular attendance and other disciplinary matters the college might notify guardians and request them to visit the college.
- 17. Any complaint of ragging in the college campus or college hostel premises will be strictly dealt with using proper legal procedures.
- 18. Students should follow the college notice board for notifications about submission of fees.









Grievance Redressal Mechanism

Our college has several avenues of communication for its students and employees to express their concerns, problems, or questions. Grievance Redressal Procedure/Mechanism is the most significant and predominant amongst them.

A **grievance** is a written claim raised by a student or an employee of the college alleging improper, arbitrary, unfair or discriminatory treatment by any of the students, employees or college administration involving the application of a specific provision of a College rule/regulation or a Governing Body policy or procedure. The grievance mechanism is available to any student or employee who believes that the environment in the college campus or treatment by any of the fellow students/employees or a decision/action taken by the College has adversely affected their status, rights, or privileges as a student or an employee. A grievance may be caused by any situation arising from an action in the college campus by any of its stakeholders causing academic, financial, emotional or physical distress to its students and employees.

Purpose of Grievance Redressal Mechanism

The purpose of this Grievance Redressal Mechanism is to define the procedure for managing stakeholder concerns and complaints (referred to as "grievances") in a planned, organized, timely, and respectful manner. This mechanism or procedure helps our esteemed institution fulfil the requirements of Human Rights Policy and alignment with institutional best practices in stakeholder engagement. In pursuit of the institution's policy of openness, accountability, and responsiveness to its students, employees and to the society, the College has established this grievance redressal mechanism to effectively and proactively manage their feedback, grievances or concerns. This mechanism aims at a prompt and impartial process for resolving grievances of the students and employees (to all concerns). It can enhance institutional outcomes by giving students and employees satisfaction that their voices are being heard and

that their issue is being subject to formal consideration within the institutional framework itself.

Grievance Redressal Committee

The College has a Grievance Redressal Committee to redress the grievance of its stakeholders and to develop a responsive and accountable attitude amongst all the stakeholders in order to maintain a harmonious educational environment in the institute. The students approach the committee to voice their grievances regarding academic issues, ragging issues, health services, library and other services. The Grievance Redressal Committee redresses the grievances by sorting out the problems promptly and judiciously.

Objectives of the Grievance Redressal Committee

- Upholding the dignity of the College by ensuring strife-free atmosphere in the College through promoting cordial relationship among all its stakeholders.
- Counselling the students to express their grievances / problems freely and frankly by putting up a grievance in writing or filling up the format available in the respective grievance registers of the departments of the college or drop it in a Grievance Box, without any fear of being victimized.
- Advising students of the College to respect the right and dignity of one another and show utmost restraint and patience whenever any occasion of rift arises.
- Advising all the students to refrain from inciting students against other students, teachers and College administration.
- Advising all staffs to be affectionate to the students and not behave in a vindictive manner towards any of them for any reason.
- Creating awareness amongst students regarding any violation of ragging and disciplinary rules; Ragging in any form is strictly prohibited in and outside the institution. Any violation of ragging and disciplinary rules is to be urgently brought to the notice of the Principal by

the Grievance Redressal Committee/Disciplinary Sub-Committee/Anti Ragging Cell/Anti Ragging Squad/Women Cell/Prevention of Sexual Harassment Cell.

Scope of the Grievance Redressal Committee

The Committee deals with grievances received in writing from the students on any of the following issues:

- Academic Issues: Related to timely issue of mark-sheets, duplicate mark-sheets, Transfer Certificates, Conduct Certificates, filling up review forms and issuing marksheets of reviewed results or other examination related matters e.g., registration, form fill-up, proper and timely information.
- Financial Issues: Related to dues and payments for various items from library, hostels etc., concessions, scholarships and so on.
- Miscellaneous: Related to certain misgivings about conditions of sanitisation, preparation of food, availability of drinking water, indoor game facilities, renovation of damaged building and availability of electric appliances in the college premises and hostel, availability of transport, any kind of victimization by the different stakeholders within the campus etc.

Functions of the Grievance Redressal Committee

The grievance issues are generally attended promptly on receipt of written grievances from the students:

- The Grievance Redressal Committee will only act upon those written cases which have been forwarded along with the necessary documents.
- The committee officially reviews all issues and acts accordingly as per the rules and regulations of the Institute
- It presents report to the authority about the cases attended to and the number of pending cases, if any, which require direction and guidance from the higher authorities.

• The Grievance Redressal Committee assures that the grievance has been properly solved in a stipulated time limit provided by the committee.

Procedure for lodging a complaint

If a student has a grievance,

- ➤ a written complaint must be logged in the prescribed petition format available in respective grievance register of his/her department
- > a note of complaint in letter format can be dropped into complaint box in front of the Principal's chamber.
- > a complaint can also be logged by filling up the institution's petition form available in the website.
- he or she may send her grievance to the Principal over email or in letter.
- > a complaint can also be reported by filling up Students' Feedback Form.

Other Stakeholders of the Institute may convey their grievances by

- lodging a written complaint in the grievance register kept in the Principal's Chamber.
- In dropping a note of complaint in letter format into complaint box in front of the Principal's chamber.
- reporting grievances to the Principal over email or in letter.
- Filling up different feedback forms: Teachers' Feedback, Alumni Feedback etc.
- raising grievances during regular Parent-Teacher Meet.

Any of these aforementioned written grievances must clearly state the complainant's name, the nature of the complaint, the name(s) of all parties directly involved in the complaint, and any appropriate documentary evidence. The complainant must sign the complaint.

Steps toward Resolution


Based upon the information presented in the grievance, informal discussion between persons directly involved in a grievance is essential in the early stages of dispute and reconciliation, and mutual resolution shall be encouraged at all stages of the procedure. Regular Parent-Teacher Meet not only presents a platform to raise grievances but it also helps in Grievance Redressal Mechanism by resolving a good number of grievance issues before delving into further complications.


Steps toward resolution shall begin with discussions within the department amongst the parties involved in the grievance directly.

If the student is not satisfied with the results of the initial discussion or if the nature of grievance can never be resolved at the initial level, then the issue is referred to the College authority (Principal) to examine the grievance. The Principal along with the convenor and members of the Grievance Redressal Committee or members / convenors of other concerned committees, student and others involved in the grievance will conduct and preside the meeting.

If a satisfactory solution cannot be reached within a reasonable period, the Principal should refer the issue to the Governing Body or the affiliated University as the case may be for further discussion and appropriate action.
