


IQAC Meeting on 06/03/2020

The meeting was presided by Dr. Swapna Ghorai, Chairperson, IQAC & Principal, Ramananda College.

Resolutions:

1. The assessment and accreditation validity by NAAC will expire on 30th April, 2020. The preparation of 3rd cycle NAAC assessment is going on in full swing. Two separate meetings with the teachers and non-teaching staff will be conducted for their whole-hearted involvement and suggestions.
2. The Grievance Redressal Cell will collect documented grievances from departments, office etc. and period of redressal and will review the issue.
3. The Library will keep regular records of users both on physical and online mode.
4. For preparation of SSR-2020, individual profile, departmental profile, office profile with document must be submitted in due time.
5. IQAC and Governing Body will review the implementation of NAAC Peer Team recommendations and take appropriate steps. Most of the recommendations have already been implemented.
6. For spoken English records will be submitted upto the period the training was conducted.
7. So far fifteen candidates have registered for coaching classes for Competitive Examinations. It is resolved that the coaching classes with them will start as early as possible.
8. Members express their satisfaction over the implementation of Computer Training for all students. It is a Computer Literacy drive for all students of the college.
9. In addition to internal Assessment and Semester End Examination, Home Assignment will be given to the students as a measure for continuous evaluation of their progress.
10. Like previous year, Yoga Training Certificate Course will be conducted this year also.
11. Following the recommendation of Women Cell and Prevention of Sexual Harassment Cell, a Self Defence (Karate) Training Programme for girl students has been conducted and it will be continued to train the girl students.
12. Indoor games facilities of girl students will be increased.
13. Seminar Hall (Virtual Classroom) will be renovated.
14. There are some senior teachers and some senior non-teaching staff who do not have adequate training for using computers and such technological devices. They will be given computer Trainings as per their professional need.
15. The Health Unit of the college will now function under supervision of Dr. Kamala Das and Dr. Deepak Kumar Singh. One non-teaching staff will be involved in this unit.
