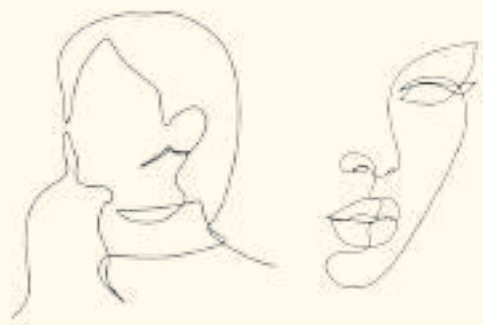

What is Stereotypes

- A generalized view or pre-conception about attributes or characteristics that are or ought to be possessed by members of a particular social group or the roles that are or should be performed by, members of a particular social group.

Stereotyping

- This implies that it is important to examine how advertisements construct specific notions on people and issues.
- In social psychology, a stereotype is a fixed, over generalized belief about a particular group or class of people. By stereotyping we infer that a person has a whole range of characteristics and abilities that we assume all members of that group have.

What is gender stereotype and what is gender stereotyping?

- Gender stereotype is a generalized view or preconception about attributes, or characteristics that are or ought to be possessed by women and men or the roles that are or should be performed by men and women. Gender stereotypes can be both positive and negative for example, “women are caring” or “women are weak”.

Gender Stereotyping & Gramsci's Cultural Hegemony

- The theory of stereotyping emerges from Gramsci's concept of 'cultural hegemony'. It states that the dominant ideologies tend to become dominant social discourses and find space and acceptance across various domains including the media.
- Gender stereotyping is one such dominant ideology which is used and re-constructed by the media. Advertising images have been reflective of the stereotypical gender images – a dimension of hegemonic ideological discourse.

Traditional perception

- Through the ages across the countries men are considered as breadwinners, decision makers, career-focused and independent, whereas women are made responsible for the well being of their families linked in to their roles as loving wife, caring mother and low-positioned worker, undertaking the bulk of house hold work.

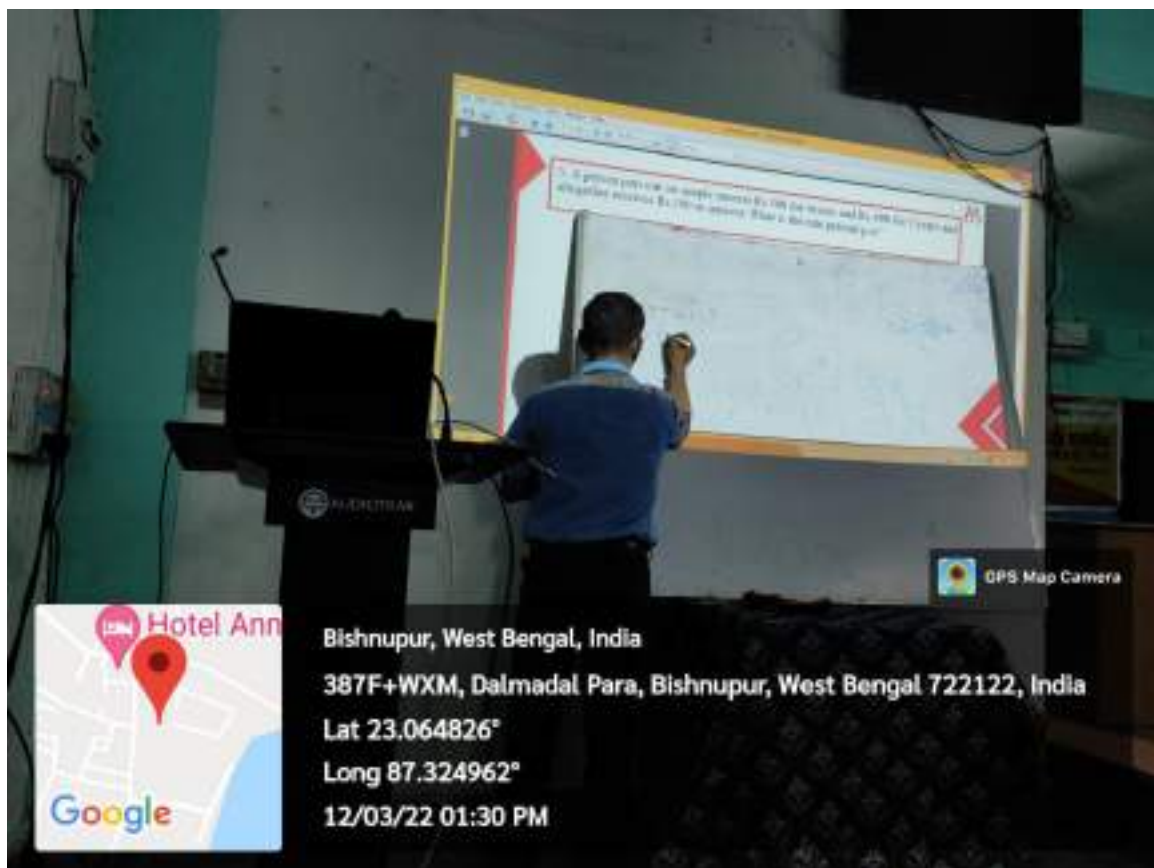

DEFINITIONS

Sexual harassment in any uninvited verbal or physical conduct or gesture of a sexual nature, required for sex or favors, or other behavior of a sexual nature that makes the recipient feel humiliated, offended, and/or left isolated. Sexual harassment also occurs in situations where such attention toward conduct is made into a working requirement or where such conduct creates an intimidating, hostile, or inappropriate working environment. The recipient's reaction must be reasonable considering the situation and circumstances at hand. In other words, sexual harassment is

- 2) Request for sexual favours
- 3) Verbal statement or physical action or gesture that describes a sexual act, or
- 4) Unwanted action of a sexual nature
- a. The recipient has made it clear that the behavior is unwanted,
- b. The recipient feels humiliated, offended and/or intimidated by the conduct; or
- c. The perpetrator should have reasonably anticipated that the other person would be
- offended, humiliated and/or intimidated by the conduct.

Types of HARASSMENT :

Harassment may take the form of words, gestures or actions that tend to annoy, shame, abuse, demean, intimidate, belittle, humiliate or embarrass another or that create an intimidating, hostile or offensive work environment. Generally, there are three forms of harassment:

- V. Non-verbal/Visual harassment: e.g. staring, leering, catcalling, threatening behavior, sexually suggestive gestures, or "flirting" with somebody else

- Use of ethnically derogatory words, phrases, epithets (Demonstration of a racist or ethnocentric nature such as a use of gestures, postures or drawings which would offend a particular racial or ethnic group)
- Comments about an individual's skin color or other racial/ethnic characteristics
- Making disparaging remarks about an individual's gender that are not usual in nature
- Negative comments about a student's religious beliefs (or lack of religious beliefs)
- Expressing negative stereotypes regarding an employee's ethnicity or ancestry
- Negative comments regarding an employee's age
- Derogatory or insulting references to an employee's marital or physical impairment
- Prejudicial remarks or derogatory jokes that have to do with an individual's personal beliefs, housing, pornography, child, age, etc.
- Sexual orientation, sexual harassment and bullying are the most prevalent forms of workplace harassment.



PREVENTION MECHANISM

The mechanism must include the following elements:

- a. A policy statement prohibiting harassment;
 - b. A clear definition of what constitutes harassment;
 - c. A complaint/ grievance procedure;
 - d. Disciplinary rules and penalties against the harasser and against those who make false accusations;
 - e. Protective and remedial measures for the victim;
 - f. Prevention and education programs to explain the company policy regarding harassment;
- and to make sanctions of harassment and adverse consequences for breach of the policy
- should be provided to all employees, supervisors, and managers of the company.
- g. Monitoring;

Prohibition & Prevention Acts

- *POCA* (Protection of Women from Sexual Offences), 2012
- The POCA Act has been implemented to prevent and protect women from sexual harassment at the workplace and thereby ensure a safe, healthy work environment for women.
- *The Objective of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012*
- To deal with child sexual abuse cases, the Government has brought in a special law.
- *Objective: The Protection of Children from Sexual Offences (POCSO) Act, 2012. The Act aims*
- *to deal with child sexual abuse cases, the Government has brought in a special law.*
