Important Instructions for Admission in P.G. Programme for the Academic Session 2021-23

1. The P.G. Admission process will be divided into two Groups- Group A and Group B **except LL.M. Programme**
2. Group A will consist of 80% of the total intake capacity both subject wise and category wise available to the home University candidates.
3. Group B will consist of 20% of the total intake capacity both subject wise and category wise available to the students of the other UGC recognised Universities.
4. Considering the pandemic situation, there will be no admission test
5. For both Group A & B admission will be held through publication of Merit List- to be prepared on the basis of Marks obtained in Graduation Level of their respective courses/ subjects.
6. After Registration the Merit List will be published. This Merit List will contain the names of all the eligible Candidates on the basis of the Marks obtained in Graduation Level of their respective courses/ subjects. Where the marks is the same, the marks secured in Higher Secondary will be considered and after that the date of birth where the marks secured by the candidates in Higher Secondary is the same. Merit list will be published subject wise and category wise. **The provisional merit list will be published for the Groups separately**
7. After publication of Merit List if any discrepancies/ anomalies/ flaws found by the candidates, they may contact the helpline or helpdesk through mobile/ e-mail etc. for rectification of error but it should be done within the due date as provided under the lists of important date.
8. Afterwards, **First Admission List** will be published. Admission list will be prepared on the basis of merit as well as the preferences opted by the candidates. Merit will always get priority in preparing admission list. During filling the form **Choice of preference is mandatory.**
9. If any seat lies vacant from the seats available to the students of either Group, **the subsequent list will be published but only within a reasonable time period in consideration of academic calendar.**
10. Unfilled seats, if any in any group after a reasonable time period can be filled up with either group. Reasonability of time period will be decided on the basis of the academic calendar so that the admission process should not affect the academic session unreasonably.

11. Admission list will contain both **Unreserved as well as Reserved Category list.**
12. **Reserved Category Students will be asked through SMS and e-mail to use their choice whether they intend to get admission by opting general list or through reserved Category.**

What is Stereotypes

- A generalized view or pre-conception about attributes or characteristics that are or ought to be possessed by members of a particular social group or the roles that are or should be performed by, members of a particular social group.

Stereotyping

- This implies that it is important to examine how advertisements construct specific notions on people and issues.
- In social psychology, a stereotype is a fixed, over generalized belief about a particular group or class of people. By stereotyping we infer that a person has a whole range of characteristics and abilities that we assume all members of that group have.

What is gender stereotype and what is gender stereotyping?

- Gender stereotype is a generalized view or preconception about attributes, or characteristics that are or ought to be possessed by women and men or the roles that are or should be performed by men and women. Gender stereotypes can be both positive and negative for example, “women are caring” or “women are weak”.

Gender Stereotyping & Gramsci's Cultural Hegemony

- The theory of stereotyping emerges from Gramsci's concept of 'cultural hegemony'. It states that the dominant ideologies tend to become dominant social discourses and find space and acceptance across various domains including the media.
- Gender stereotyping is one such dominant ideology which is used and re-constructed by the media. Advertising images have been reflective of the stereotypical gender images – a dimension of hegemonic ideological discourse.

Traditional perception

- Through the ages across the countries men are considered as breadwinners, decision makers, career-focused and independent, whereas women are made responsible for the well being of their families linked in to their roles as loving wife, caring mother and low-positioned worker, undertaking the bulk of house hold work.

DEFINITIONS

Sexual harassment is any unwanted verbal or physical conduct or gesture of a sexual nature, request for sexual favors, or other behavior of a sexual nature that makes the recipient feel humiliated, offended, and/or intimidated. Sexual harassment also occurs in situations when such unwanted conduct is made into a working environment or when such conduct creates an intimidating, hostile, or inappropriate working environment. The recipient's reaction must be reasonable considering the situation and circumstances at hand. In other words, sexual harassment is:

Types of HARASSMENT :

Harassment may take the form of words, gestures or actions that tend to annoy, alarm, abuse, demean, intimidate, belittle, humiliate or embarrass another or that create an intimidating, hostile or offensive work environment. Generally, there are three forms of harassment.

- I. Physical harassment: e.g. (sexual) violence or unwelcome physical contact such as kissing or touching
- II. Verbal harassment: e.g. comments, offensive jokes, personal insults, derogatory language
- III. Non-verbal/Visual harassment: e.g. staring, leering, whistling, threatening behavior, sexually suggestive gestures, or "flirting" somebody out

- 3) Mixture of sexual behaviour
- 2) Request for sexual favours
- 3) Verbal statement or physical action or gesture that describes a sexual act, or
- 4) Unwanted action of a sexual nature
- a. The recipient has made it clear that the behavior is unwanted,
- b. The recipient feels humiliated, offended and/or intimidated by the conduct; or
- c. The perpetrator should have reasonably anticipated that the other person would be
- offended, humiliated and/or intimidated by the conduct.

- Examples of harassment:
 - Use of ethnically derogatory words, phrases, epithets / Demonstration of a racial or ethnic nature such as a use of gestures, postures or drawings which would offend a particular racial or ethnic group
 - Comments about an individual's skin color or other racial / ethnic characteristics
 - Making disparaging remarks about an individual's gender that are not sexual in nature
 - Negative comments about a student's religious beliefs (or lack of religious beliefs)
 - Expressing negative stereotypes regarding an employee's intelligence or ancestry
 - Negative comments regarding an employee's age
 - Derogatory or insulting references to an employee's marital or physical impairment
 - Prejudicial remarks or taunting jokes that have to do with an individual's personality traits, drawing pornography clips, etc., or
 - Sexual orientation. Sexual harassment and bullying are two of the most prevalent forms of workplace harassment.



PREVENTION MECHANISM:

The mechanism must include the following elements:

- a. A policy statement prohibiting harassment;
- b. A clear definition of what constitutes harassment;
- c. A complaint/grievance procedure;
- d. Disciplinary rules and penalties against the harasser and against those who make false accusations;
- e. Protective and remedial measures for the victim;
- f. Preventive and education programs to explain the company policy regarding harassment and to raise awareness of harassment and adverse consequences for breach of the policy;
- g. Monitoring.

Prohibition & Prevention Acts

- POSH (Protection of Women from Sexual Harassment) Act, 2017
- The POSH Act has been implemented to prevent and protect women from sexual harassment at the workplace and thereby ensure a safe working environment for women.
- In October of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences (POCSO) Act, 2012
- To deal with child sexual abuse cases, the Government has brought in a special law.
- provide The Protection of Children from Sexual Offences (POCSO) Act, 2012, The Act has
- come into force with effect from 14th November, 2012 along with the Bala Saksham Scheme.
