## Author guidelines

### (1) Aims and scope

**Frontiers in multidisciplinary research** is a multidisciplinary peer-reviewed journal with a very wide-ranging coverage, consolidates fundamental and applied research activities by publishing original research articles in all areas of (1) Physical Sciences, (2) Chemical sciences, (3) Engineering, (4) Biological Sciences/Health Sciences, (5) Medicine, (6) Computer and Information Sciences, (7) Mathematical Sciences, (8) Agriculture Science and Engineering, (9) Geosciences, and (10) Energy/Fuels/Environmental/Green Science and Engineering, and (11) Literature and Language Studies, (12) Education, (13) Social Sciences and Public Policies, (14) History and Culture Studies, (15) Philosophy, (16) Economics, (17) Music and (18) Commerce.

The journal is intended for a very broad audience working in all fields mentioned above.

### (2) Instruction to authors

**Submission:** Only online submissions are accepted to facilitate rapid publication and minimize administrative costs. Lone PDF (.pdf) or Word (.doc, .docx, .rtf) files of the manuscripts should be submitted online by one of the authors through E-mail. The word limit of the manuscript is 5000. Submissions by anyone other than one of the authors will not be accepted. The submitting author takes responsibility for the paper during submission and peer review.

**Terms of Submission:** Papers must be submitted on the understanding that those have not been published elsewhere and are not currently under consideration by another journal published by any other publisher. The submitting author is responsible for ensuring that the article's publication has been approved by all the other co-authors. It is also the authors' responsibility to ensure that the articles emanating from a particular institution are submitted with the approval of the necessary institution. Only an acknowledgment from the editorial office officially establishes the date of receipt. Further correspondence and proofs will be sent to the author(s) before publication unless otherwise indicated. It is a condition of submission of a paper that the authors permit editing of the paper for readability.

**Peer Review:** All manuscripts are subject to peer review and are expected to meet standards of academic excellence. If approved by the editor, submissions will be considered by peer-reviewers, whose identities will remain anonymous to the authors.

**Article Processing Charges:** **Frontiers in multidisciplinary research** is an open access journal. Open access charges allow publishers to make the published material available for free to all interested online visitors. The expenditure will be borne by Ramananda College. Authors will not have to pay for publications of their manuscripts.

**Units of Measurement:** Units of measurement should be presented simply and concisely using System International (SI) units.

**Title and Authorship Information:** The following information should be included-

*Paper title*

*Full author names*

*Full institutional mailing addresses*

*Email addresses*

**Abstract:** The manuscript should contain an abstract. The abstract should be self-contained and citation-free and should not exceed 200 words.

**Introduction:** This section should be succinct, with no subheadings.

**Materials and Methods:** This part should contain sufficient detail so that all procedures can be repeated. It can be divided into subsections if several methods are described.

**Results and Discussion:** This section may each be divided by subheadings or may be combined.

**Conclusions:** This should clearly explain the main conclusions of the work highlighting its importance and relevance.

**Acknowledgments:** All acknowledgments (if any) should be included at the very end of the paper before the references and may include supporting grants, presentations, and so forth.

**References:** Authors are responsible for ensuring that the information in each reference is complete and accurate. All references must be numbered consecutively and citations of references in text should be identified using numbers in superscripts (e.g., "as discussed by Smith<sup>9</sup>"; "as discussed elsewhere<sup>9,10</sup>"). All references should be cited within the text; otherwise, these references will be automatically removed. For reference list, following convention should be followed:

**Preparation of Figures:** Upon submission of an article, authors are supposed to include all figures and tables in the PDF file of the manuscript. Figures and tables should not be submitted in separate files. If the article is accepted, authors will be asked to provide the source files of the figures. Each figure should be supplied in a separate electronic file. All figures should be cited in the paper in a consecutive order. Figures should be supplied in either vector art formats (Word, CorelDraw, PowerPoint, Excel, etc.) or bitmap formats (Photoshop, TIFF, GIF, JPEG, etc.). Bitmap images should be of 300 dpi resolution at least unless the resolution is intentionally set to a lower level for scientific reasons. If a bitmap image has labels, the image and labels should be embedded in separate layers.

**Preparation of Tables:** Tables should be cited consecutively in the text. Every table must have a descriptive title and if numerical measurements are given, the units should be included in the column heading. Vertical rules should not be used.

**Proofs:** Corrected proofs must be returned to the publisher within 2-3 days of receipt. The publisher will do everything possible to ensure prompt publication. It will therefore be appreciated if the manuscripts and figures conform from the outset to the style of the journal.

**Warranties and copyrights:** By submitting the manuscript, the authors warrant that the entire work is original and unpublished, it is submitted only to this Journal and all text, data, figures/tables or other illustrations included in the research article are completely original and unpublished, and these have not been previously published or submitted elsewhere in any form or media whatsoever. All authors are responsible for the complete contents of their manuscript.

### **(3) Ethical Guidelines**

In the case of any animal experiments, the authors must provide a full description of any anaesthetic or surgical procedure used, as well as evidence that all possible steps were taken to avoid animal suffering at each stage of the experiment.
